

2023 Victorian Landscape Awards Judging Sheet for Feature in the Landscape (The Grant Saltmarsh Memorial Award)



Entrant	Project Address

Note to Category Judge:

The entrant MUST be the author of the design to enter, or the author/builder.

Whether it is artistic, unique, appropriate or juxtaposed, the Feature must hold a strong sense of presence within its surrounding environment and display exceptional trade skills in execution.

Judges should be considering this category in terms of how well the feature serves as a keystone to the entire project. Judging is not about the actual construction of the feature as it may have been fabricated / constructed offsite, it is the design solution that is sought and how well it has been achieved.

A whole landscape is not eligible to be considered a 'feature'. The feature must account for less than 50% of the overall landscape.

Each entry gets a mark out of 110. This is converted into a percentage and then ranked in this way.
