Job Responsibilities (include but are not limited to):

- 1. Operate vehicles plant and equipment excavators, trucks, skid steer, tractor, mowers, water truck, roller and associated attachments etc.
- 2. Assist your Project supervisor to practical completion on time, safely and with the client satisfying quality
- 3. Ensure that your tasks are sequenced correctly and that uniform methods/systems and safe work procedures are adhered to
- 4. Communicate required resources clearly and daily (materials, plant and equipment, staff)
- 5. Ensure that each delivery of goods is being physically checked for quality and quantity
- 6. Storing materials efficiently and securely to minimise double handling and theft
- 7. Evaluate the quality of work being done and discuss any shortcomings with Project Supervisor
- 8. Liaise with sub-contractors and report back to Project supervisor
- 9. Conducting inspections at critical phases and hold points and report back to Project supervisor
- 10. Liaise with Project supervisor regarding the progress of the project
- 11. Collaborate with Project supervisor if they have any input to assist in completing the task's more efficiently and safer
- 12. Operate above the line at all times, ownership, accountability, responsibility
- 13. Update job knowledge by tracking and understanding emerging construction practices and standards
- 14. Ensure that site and all facilities, including worker's amenities are kept clean, orderly and hygienic at all times
- 15. Ensure that the site is secured and safe at the completion of each work day
- 16. Ensure that equipment used on site is in a safe operating condition and all checks have been done including your vehicle (Google Drive, hire shop)
- 17. Must follow the site safety plan, SMP, EMP, TMP and ensures it is enforced on site
- 18. Ensure contractors follow site rules and report to Project supervisor
- 19. Ensure that Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) are worn as required by WHS legislation, industry standards and company policies
- 20. Be familiar with emergency procedures, the locations of First Aid equipment and Fire extinguishers and first aid officers
- 21. Conduct regular Risk and Hazard inspections, fix hazards or, if you can't, promptly raise the issue with the Project supervisor.
- 22. Ensures that all other Safe Workplace Procedures and related company policies are followed at all times
- 23. Any other job-related tasks as directed by management
