- Make the best use of the available space, feeling neither empty nor cluttered/forced and uses the borrowed landscape effectively
- Have a strong and cohesive plant and materials palette with a strong link back to the underlying themes of the garden
- Be at a comfortable human scale with a strong sense of proportion (elements looking natural and right) providing variety without too much going on
- Have a sense of balance achieved either through symmetrical or asymmetrical design
- Be visually appealing

Criteria 5 - Design cohesion & unity has a sense of entry with connection to the whole garden and makes good use of available space & any borrowed landscape.

Continuity across planting & materials palette with links back to the underlying garden theme.

### Best Gardens will:

- Have healthy, quality plants with no pest of disease damage, of good size, not water stressed or scorched
- Be a strong reflection of real-world good planting design. Plants will be selected with consideration of sun/shade patterns, water usage. Designers may choose to plant existing microclimates
- Display exemplary planting design with strong attention to form, colour, texture, and accent. Overall effect will be strong and well balanced, a unified design which still displays variation and with an appropriate mix of trees, shrubs, groundcovers, and climbers if appropriate
- Include innovative plant selections in taxa, associations and how plants are used. They may include unusual plants used in creative ways
- Have all plants clean, well placed, full in the pot and tidy of appearance. Shaped plants achieve the design intent. Pots will not be visible with complete plant cover in planting areas
